



AUSTRALIAN PASSPORTS: LIST OF ADDITIONAL IDENTITY DOCUMENTS

You will need specific documents to prove your identity. You must provide the following combinations of original documents:

- **Combination 1:** One document from category A, and one document from category B
- **Combination 2:** Two documents from category B and one official document that includes your photo
- **Combination 3:** At least three documents from category C that shows your name and current address and one official document that includes your photo

Note (in all cases): If neither of these documents shows your current address, you must also provide one document from **category C** that shows your current address.

Category A (All Category A documents must be current at the time of application)

- Current driving licence issued by an Australian/foreign government driving/traffic/motor vehicle licensing authority
- Foreign residency card
- Australian Proof of Age or Photo Card

Category B (All Category B documents must be current at the time of application, except for the Australian passport)

- Health card issued by a government authority
- Credit card or bank account card with current signature on the back
- Foreign passport
- National Insurance card
- Previous Australian Passport issued on or after 1 July 2000 with more than two years validity that has not been expired for over ten years

Category C (All Category C documents must be no more than 12 months old at the time of application and show your current residential address)

- Utility bills
- Bank or Credit card statement with residential address
- Motor vehicle registration or insurance papers
- Property rates notice or property lease agreement
