## **Annex 8 - Occupational Guarantor Occupation Groups**

## Introduction

The applicant's identity must be clearly established. Overseas offices may accept a Guarantor Declaration from either:

- the holder of a current Australian passport with at least two years validity; or,
- the local equivalents of the occupational categories listed at below.

To qualify as a Guarantor the person must:

Not be related to the Applicant by birth or marriage	Be 18 years of age or over
Not be in a de facto relationship with the Applicant (this includes same sex relationship), nor live at the same address	Endorse the back of one photograph by writing "This is a true photo of (Applicant's full name) and sign it
Have known the Applicant for at least 12 months, or since birth for a child applicant who is under 1 years of age	Be able to satisfy and complete either sections 12 A or 12 B on the PC8 form and sign the declaration
