Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to apply,

- (a) You must be a citizen of Bangladesh
- (b) You must be less than 40 years old at the time of applying.
- (c) You must have completed a university level qualification which is at least equivalent in standard to an Australian Bachelors degree. Candidates with high level academic results in one or more university level degrees are encouraged to apply.
- (d) Nominate only one field of study from the list provided in the website. The field of study can not be changed once you have been short-listed.
- (e) You should have at least two years of work experience relevant to the field of study for which you are applying.
- (f) You are expected to have strong English language skills. You must submit the results of IELTS Academic Test. The overall test score must be at least 6.5 with no individual band being less than 6, and the exam date should not be earlier than 1 November 2007. IELTS exam taken earlier than 1 November 2007 will not be accepted and the application will be disgualified.

In addition to the above, the short listing process will constitute of the following criteria:

- Fifty percent of scholarships will be awarded to female candidates and fifty percent will be awarded to male candidates.
- Preference will be given to female and male candidates of tribal descent.
- Preference will be given to candidates who have <u>not</u> previously undertaken postgraduate studies abroad
- Preference will be given to candidates who are not dual nationals of an OECD country.

You will not be eligible if you:

- (a) Are holding or have been nominated to receive another scholarship;
- (b) Are a permanent resident or have applied for permanent residency in Australia;
- (c) Are married or engaged to be married to a person who holds or who is eligible to hold Australian or New Zealand citizenship or permanent residence status.

Applications

Before submitting an application, ensure that you meet the eligibility criteria outlined above and that you have provided all the required supporting documentation.

Ineligible or incomplete applications will not be considered.

All information provided in support of your application for ADS must be true and correct.

AusAID reserves the right to verify the contents of academic transcripts and other claims made by applicants. Applicants found to be submitting false, incorrect or misleading information will be disqualified from the ADS program.

Applications sent by fax or email will not be considered.

Those applicants submitting more than one application will not be considered.

Applications submitted for 2009 will not be held over for 2010 or future years.

ADS awardees will be selected by the ADS selection panel convened by the Australian High Commission, Dhaka. Decisions of the selection panel are final and confidential and no correspondence regarding outcomes of the selection process will be entered into. Successful applicants will be notified of results in July/August 2009.

Applicants must ensure that the following documentation is received by AusAID in one package, by **30 April 2009**. Incomplete applications and applications omitting any required supporting documentation will be regarded as **ineligible** and **will not be considered**.

1. Application Forms should be signed and dated by the applicant.

2. Supporting documents: Certified copies of all supporting documents must be submitted together with the ADS Application form by **30 April 2009**.

- Birth certificate: Certified true copies of your birth certificate. If the original document is in a language other than English you should also provide an English translation. DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.
- Photocopy of Passport: Certified true copies of the personal data page from your passport providing official evidence of your full name, date of birth, gender and country of citizenship is required. DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS
- Graduation Certificate, Degree or Diploma: Certified true copies of the Graduation Certificate(s), Degree(s) or Diploma(s) of all university-level academic qualifications completed by the applicant (in original language and translated into English). DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS
- Secondary and Higher Secondary school certificates: Certified true copies of the Secondary (or equivalent) and Higher Secondary (or equivalent) Certificate(s) completed by the applicant (in original language and translated into English). DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.
- Full academic transcripts: Certified true copies of full academic transcript(s), showing grades for all university-level, HSC (or equivalent) and SSC (or equivalent) level subjects/units attempted by the applicant (in original language and translated into English). DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.
- ✓ IELTS Certificate(s): Certified true copies of IELTS Certificate(s) demonstrating results of English tests completed since 1 November 2007.
- ✓ Police Clearance Certificate: Certified true copies of police clearance certificate must be submitted with the application form.

Note: If you have appeared for O/A level exams / if your results are graded in CGPA, you must provide the marks obtained and the official percentile calculation of the total marks. Proof of the official calculation has to be submitted with the mark sheets

Certification: To certify a document as a true copy applicant should present the original document and a copy to a Public Notary or other formally recognized authority in Bangladesh. This official should sight both documents and certify with a stamp or a signature or both that the copy presented is a true copy of the original document. Note that the cost of any fees charged by notaries for certification of documents must be borne by the applicant.

- You should prepare a "hard copy" application and submit it by mail.
- Applicants must provide one set of certified true copies of all supporting documentation.
- Make sure you retain a copy of your application form for your own reference. Also make sure that you send *certified true copies* of supporting documents. Do not submit the original copies of your supporting documents.
- Applications with incomplete documentation, faulty or false information will be rejected.
- Applications and attachments will not be returned.
